Growth Mind-set

Over the past few years staff have been exploring their own Growth Mind-set and how this impacts on them as individuals. We have also worked to develop and embed a Growth Mind-set in our children. Our Growth Mind-set words are:

> Resilience Challenge **Effort** Thinking Perseverance Trial and Improvement Reflection

Staff use this vocabulary in school to support the children to become independent learners who challenge themselves to improve. Remember there is no such this as 'I can't do it'... at OLOL we say 'I can't do it YET'.

Year 4


Year 4 have been revisiting place value. They have been working hard to solve word problems with pictures and diagrams.














Year 5
