Why we wear a school uniform?

Winter uniform must be worn from the first Monday of October until the Easter/Spring holiday at the end of the Spring Term. This applies to all children from Year 1 to Year 6. Reception children should start school in September in Winter uniform.

Summer uniform must be worn from the beginning of the Summer Term (after the Easter/Spring break) until the Friday preceding the first Monday in October.

Please do not mix and match items from the Winter/Summer uniform lists.

NB: In the event of extreme weather conditions the school shall extend the dates above appropriately and shall inform parents accordingly.

Please ensure that the correct uniform is worn at all times.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly marked with the child's own name.

School Bags

Children from Nursery to Year 4 must use a school book bag, these are available from the school office. Year 5 and Year 6 children may use a sensible ruck sack. If your child requires an additional kit for an after school club, they are permitted to bring this in a small bag or rucksack. School rucksacks are available but are not compulsory.

Shoes

Black school shoes. Trainers, boots or 'fashion' shoes are not allowed.

School ties

Ties are available from school and Forest Casuals. Elasticated versions shall be sold to parents of Reception and Year 1 children only.

Coats

Children should wear a school-type coat, appropriate for wet weather conditions. This should be worn over the school cardigan or pullover. Coats should not have logos or slogans on them. Sweatshirts/hooded sweat tops are not allowed.

Hats

The office sells school baseball and winter hats. The baseball hat is recommended for protection against the sun.

Jewellery

Children are only permitted to wear small studs and small sleeper earrings as a pair. However, all earrings will need to be taken out or taped up by individual pupils for PE or any other activity. No other jewellery is allowed. This is due to health and safety concerns and to enable all children to take a full part in all areas of the curriculum. Pupils from Year 2 upwards may wear a simple wristwatch if they choose to do so. Children are responsible for their own watches and may need to remove them for certain activities.

Hair

In the interests of health and safety, long hair must be tied back. All ribbons, clips and hair accessories should be in school colours - royal blue. No Hair ornaments are permitted

PE Kit

Black plimsolls, plain navy/royal blue or black shorts, white t-shirt with/without school logo. PE kit should be kept in a drawstring PE/gym bag. Pupils in KS2 (Years 3 to 6) are permitted to wear trainers for indoor and outdoor PE.

Tracksuits

What support is available for families who need additional financial support?
